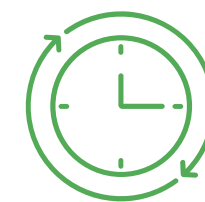
Sprint 3: Executing Innovation & Change Projects

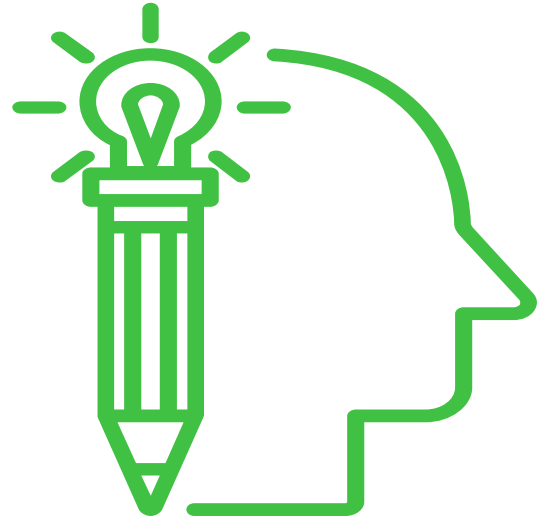
